



ABOUT SUMMER WORKSHOP

1. The procedure for the submission of participation forms will be in effect until April 30, 2017.
2. After April 30, the coordination team, consisting of professors of the five Universities, will evaluate the entries submitted. Those selected will be notified in writing.
3. The selected applicants are required to pay the entry fee of € 60 by May 15, 2017. For convenience of the students and young architects coming from abroad, the Cyprus Architects Association will announce the payment options.
4. In case any participant settle the payment but for any reason that will not permit him to attend the Stage A' of the workshop (start date 14 June 2017) the amount will be refunded, but that participant will not be entitled to participate in the Stage B' which is the completion of construction in Kenya and the place will be given to a runner-up.
5. As specified in the brief, the Summer Workshop is a two Stage workshop. For the year 2017 (Stage A') will deal with the design of the architectural study in Nicosia. For 2018 (Stage B') the team will travel to Nairobi (Kenya) to support the implementation of the construction. The trip to Kenya will be held if the Volunteer Doctors – Cyprus ensure timely the relevant building permits and financing of the project. Right of travel to Kenya have only the Stage A' participants. Participants are responsible for the travel and accommodation costs in Kenya. Efforts will be made to ensure special prices for fares and accommodation.
6. Interested participants are encouraged to promptly submit the entry form, as one of the evaluation criteria is the application date.
7. The number of participants in the Stage A' will not exceed the number of 50.
8. The amount of €60 refers to the Stage A' participation fees.
9. As the agenda states, the workshop will focus on research and experimentation, the architectural and building - construction design, large and small scale model construction.
10. Participants will have the opportunity to engage in theoretical and practical approach issues, will contact with traditional methods - local constructions of Kenya, combined with modern tools of design and construction.
11. The detailed program will be given to the participants on the first day of the Workshop.
12. The Stage A' Laboratory will be held at the Department of Architecture of the University of Cyprus (68 Ledra str. Nicosia). The other local Universities will host activities and events which will be announced on the first day of the Workshop.
13. Events and activities on the Workshop's theme will be held at key points of the old area in Nicosia in order to inform the general public (details will be announced later).
